The minimum equitable salaries for members in full connection, whose primary field of service is within a local congregation, charge, or cooperative parish, shall be \$28,000; probationary and associate members \$27,300; full-time local pastors \$26,800, with increments of \$300 for each year of full-time service, up to 15 years. This recommendation shall take effect for all churches on January 1, 2007.
